Course (Level): PUBLICATIONS 1 (Level 1)

Length: 1 Semester

Credit: 1/2 Credit per Semester

Description:

Students in this class design, produce, and sell the Beehive, the school yearbook. Activities include developing a theme, planning the essential coverage of the school, selecting a photography studio, organizing the senior portrait sessions, scheduling the underclass portraits in the late fall, taking spring sports photographs, and developing a rough ladder diagram.

Grading Your Work: All of your work is graded on a scale of 5 to 1, with 5 being the highest grade you can receive and 1 being the lowest. If you provide little or no work for a particular assessment, you receive a zero. Refer to your handbook for more details.

Calculating Your Grade: Your quarterly grade is based on a variety of assessment measures. The specific types of assessment to be used and their weights relative to one another, or their percentage of your overall grade, are:

- Quizzes
- Projects 40%
- Term Papers
- Essays
- Performances
- Labs
- Class Participation 40%Homework 30%
